Our overseas development supporters offer advice on overcoming challenges to ensure more successful and effective business negotiations.

Support Details

- We provide (online) consultations with overseas development supporters who provide advice for business negotations with overseas companies, and will conduct follow-up support.
- Free interpretation services during business matching.
- Arranged business matchings with exhibiting overseas companies.

- Your company must have a physical presence in Osaka City. (Head office, branch office, sales office etc.)
- You must be willing to cooperate with surveys and interviews during and after the trade fair for result assessment.

Who are our overseas development supporters?

Our overseas development supporters are current and former professionals from business firms, trading companies, manufacturers, and consultants. They possess a wealth of expertise across various genres (regions, products, technologies, etc.) as well as specialized knowledge of trade practices. Supporters provide support tailored to with respect to enterprises' specific needs, from the initial preparation stages for business matching, to on-site support, as well as follow-up meetings.

What kind of support do you provide specifically? How long does the support period last?

We provide advice on foreign market trends, sales/marketing methods, various promotional tools, intellectual properties, etc. Overseas development supporters will also be present at the trade fair to provide business matching support. There is a follow-up period for a maximum of 6 months (or until March 31st, 2026) during which advice is giving on items as product improvement, consideration of transaction conditions, business terms, and contract procedures.



What types of companies are eligible for support?

Support from the overseas development supporters is limited to SMEs that have head offices, branch offices, sales offices in Osaka City. Any Osaka-based company can apply for "Business Meetings in Osaka" and the seminars as mentioned at "Providing International Business Information".
